Investigate..
 Study the skills of the lesson in detail.

Discuss the piece of stimulus artwork/ design. Look at the skills they are learning about in the lesson. Possibly compare previous artworks/ designs used. Express opinions on the piece. Learn about the artist / designer where appropriate.

Use sketchbooks to respond to the artwork / design. Individually or in pairs.
 Watch video input about the skill within the lesson if appropriate.
 Discuss artistic terms used and understand the effects created.
 Discuss the materials used.

Teacher demonstration of the skill(s) being taught in the lesson.
 Discuss the materials used and how they may be different to those in the stimulus.
 Discuss outcome for the task.

Children complete the main creative piece individually or in groups.
 Children respond to each other's work and comment on the success in terms of achieving the skill. Compare success to stimulus.

Appreciate and evaluate..
 Appraise each other's work.

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What will art look like in the classroom?

Some art on display either inside or outside the classroom

Ideally—named and explained

Pieces of art regularly attached to activities on Seesaw.

How will art be assessed?

Assess the unit at the end and record names on the Medium Term Plan for that half term. Each unit builds towards an innovative final piece which is an accumulation of what has been learned.

What does greater depth look like in art?

The key to greater depth in art is showing a deeper understanding of how they are influenced by the style and techniques of other artists and discuss using these in their work.

Where is art resourced?

Some units, including all those on sculpture and famous artists, come from 'Plan Bee' and are stored on Teams. For others, you are free to choose how to teach it, covering the objectives required from the progression map.
